AYUSH Scholarship Scheme for the Academic Year 2022-23

The Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India is offering AYUSH scholarships for Academic Year (AY) 2022-23 for the undergraduate, post graduate and Ph.D courses related to Yoga, Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy in Indian Universities/Institutes/Colleges. The last date of application is 15th July 2022.

Important Instructions

- 1. Applications from interested students for AY 2022-23 will be accepted online through the A2A Scholarship portal www.a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in. Interested applicants are advised to visit the above mentioned website to commence their application process and familiarize themselves with different universities/institutes. It is also advised to do thorough research of courses offered, guidelines, eligibility criteria and general information before applying for admission.
- 2. For undergraduate courses in AYUSH, applicant must have 12 years of schooling with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry & Biology). For Post graduate courses, applicant must have bachelor's degree in the relevant course recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM). For Ph.D courses, applicant must have MD degree in the relevant course recognized by Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM).
- 3. No application will be accepted after last date of application.
- 4. The application will be processed only for the course applied for. No request for the change of course will be entertained later.
- 5. The applicant has to fill 03 choices of Universities/Institutes in the application in order of preference. If no seats are available in the choice of University given by the applicant, the allocation will be done by the Ministry of AYUSH in other University as per availability of seats.
- 6. No request for the transfer of University will be entertained at any stage once the admission is confirmed.
- 7. Candidate has to confirm/deny the offer of admission within 15 days of receiving the offer, after which it will be considered that the candidate is not interested and the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the waiting list.
- 8. There is no provision for health/medical insurance for the AYUSH scholars.
- 9. Embassy of India, Tehran will provide economy class Airfare by shortest route to the scholars at the time of admission. The same will be provided by ICCR after the completion of the course.
