- i. Age: The programme is open to youth of Indian origin (excluding non-resident Indians) in the age group of 21-35 years. Non Resident Indians (NRIs) are not eligible for KIPs.
- ii. Educational Qualification: Minimum qualification required for participating in KIP is graduation from a recognized University. Applicants pursuing graduation are not eligible to apply.
